To support the learning in school please complete **at least 3** of these activities over the course of this half term. You can choose to do one per week if you would like.

- Do you have a pet? Write or draw a picture to tell me all about your pet. If you don't have a pet, what animal would get if you were able to have a pet? Why would you want that animal as a pet?
- Read a story book with an animal on the front cover. Tell me what book you have read and why you did/didn't like it. You can write your answer or verbally tell me in class time.
