To support the learning in school please complete at least 3 of these activities over the course of this half term. You can choose to do one per week if you would like.

Prepare your costume / outfit for our Victorian School Day.



Find out how many countries were in the British Empire.
What did Britain trade?

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

The Victorians were excellent recyclers. Old clothes would be torn into sections and made into rag rugs. These would start as blankets, then rugs, then door mats before finally landing on the compost heap. Create a poster to encourage people to reduce, reuse, recycle. Alternatively make a rag rug with some adult help.

Make a Victorian game e.g. doll's house, doll, ball and cup, Jacob's ladder



Visit Wightwick Manor, Ironbridge Gorge, the Birmingham Back to Backs, Blitz Hill.
Record facts you learn from your visit in any way you choose to share with your class mates.

Carry out some research about something Victorian: the first FA cup final, a Victorian invention, the Industrial Revolution, Victorian factories, buildings, the dentist, the highstreet, clothes, etc There is so much to choose from! (Please ensure an adult is with you when researching on the internet.)



Did Queen Victoria ever visit the local area? How do you know?



The Victorians invented Christmas as we know it. Make some Victorian style decorations. You could even get baking and enjoy some Victorian Christmas treats such as sugar plums or figgy pudding.
