- Are there any local castles in our area? Grab a map or use google maps and using your knowledge of symbols from last term, see how many you can find.
- What stories do you know about Kings, Queens, castles and dragons? Can you write a short summary of your favourite story?

- Can you find out more about the Scientist who invented the Macintosh coat? Present your findings anyway you would like.
- Can you make a collage of a face from using different features cut out of magazines and newspapers?
- Can you find out about the Royal family? Can you make a family tree to show who is in your own family?
- > Design a royal crown or a coat of arms to present your family.
