The Albrighton Foodbank is an initiative of all the churches in Albrighton, working together to provide emergency food supplies to anyone who may need them.

Staffed by volunteers and relying on donations of food and other items; we are open Friday mornings (9.30 – 10.30 am) and can offer support to clients who are referred to us with a food voucher.



We offer a weekly supply of food and other household items for up to three weeks for all who are referred to us.

As of Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020, not all of our usual distribution centres will be open, if you already have one of our red foodbank vouchers please call 01543 422394 between 9am-1pm for advice on how to redeem it. Coniston Clothing is temporarily closed during this crisis. If you do need emergency clothing please contact the foodbank help line.

### HOW TO HELP US

- 1. **Keep donating food** and other essentials: visit <u>https://cannockdistrict.foodbank.org.uk/give-help/donate-food/</u> for an up to date list of 'shortages'. Items can either be dropped off at supermarket market collection points or taken to our central warehouse at Coniston Hall Cecil St, Cannock WS11 5DB.
- 2. **Donate money**: Every time we help a family with £40 worth of food, it costs us £5. Visit <u>https://cannockdistrict.foodbank.org.uk/give-help/donate-money/</u> to help us keep the lights on and staff paid at this time.
- 3. **Volunteer**: We have just slim lined our entire foodbank operation but over the coming weeks we may need a few more people to help with deliveries and helping man our warehouse.
